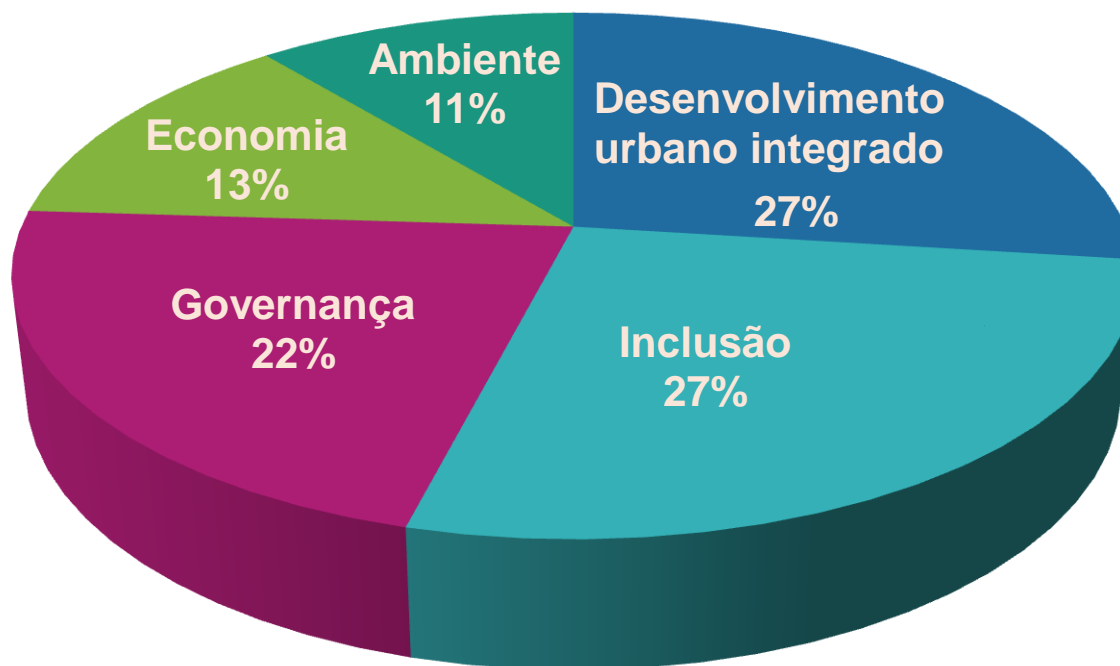
- ◆ Concurso aberto entre Dezembro 2016 e Março 2017

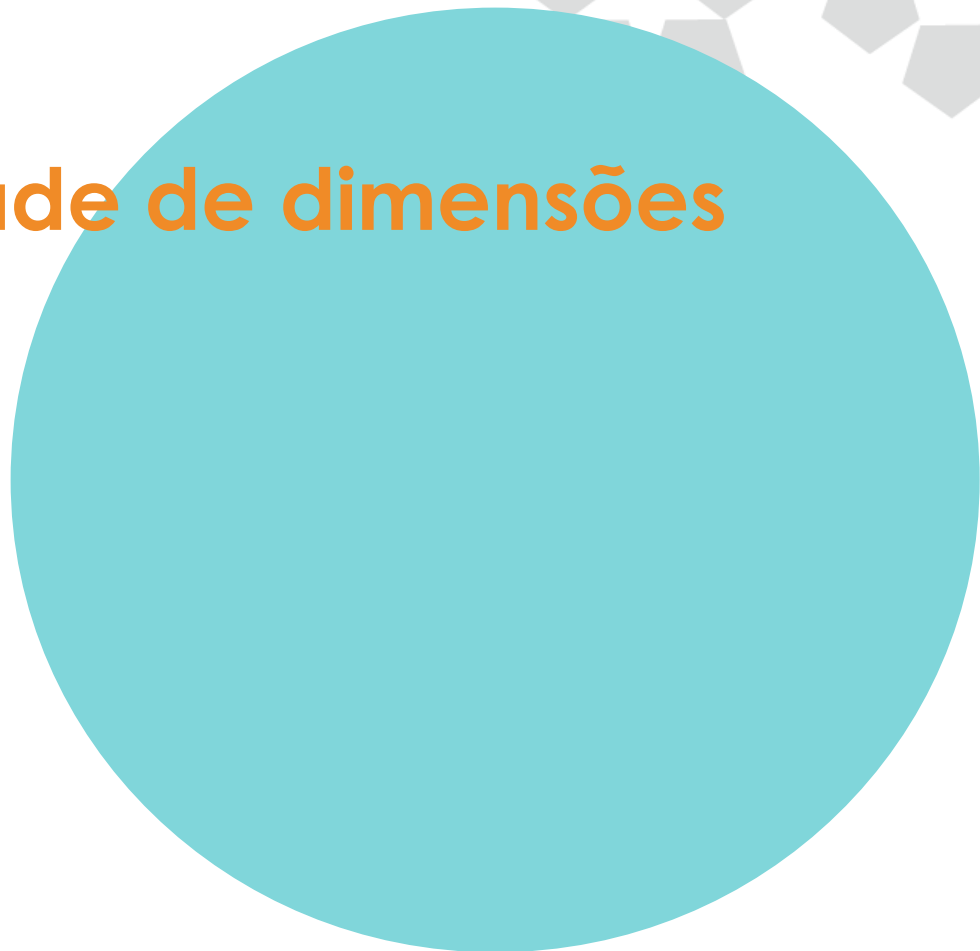
Distribuição temática
