articipatory Budget of Águeda

- 1. Citizens decide on €500.000 of the Municipal Budget (~10%)
- 2. Deliberative and municipal scope
- 3. Citizens 16 yo and over may present proposals in local sessions and later on vote the projects (up to €50.000 each project)

Action- Reflection-Action

1. Weekly meetings of the PB Committee (CAT) – Heads of Divisions, Technical Units, Member of Municipal Assembly, under the Mayor's coordination

2. Issues are identified, strategies to deal with are discussed, i.e. solutions are not delayed



Action- Reflection-Action

3. Continuous improvement throughout the process and its diferent phases (Definition & Execution of the Budget)



- 1. Understand the profile of the participants (age, gender, origin, education, return rate)
- 2. Understand their concerns and interests, as well as assess citizen satisfaction





- 3. Identify barriers throughtout the process
- 4. Identify improvement opportunities
- 5. With independent external consultant; accompanies the process (unbiased view)



hat difference has it made?

PB-Águeda is followed by a sociological study to understand participation habits:

- 1. Age, gender, origin, education level, involvement in local associations
- 2. Understand skills (vs needs) in information and communication technologies



hat difference has it made?

- 3. Knowledge about population needs, fitting them in appropriate programmes outside PB-Águeda
- 4. Involvement of the entire municipal services in PB-Águeda
- 5. Best National Participative Practice in 2015 (Network of Participative)

1. It's inclusive, in terms of digital literacy, writing skills, access to participatory sessions, conciliation of family life and active citizenship

2. It has the potencial to attract an increasing number of new participants
